They loved the island's people, culture, and the land itself. They split their time between



Honolulu and Makaweli. Both were active in the community with P.E.O. being central to both their social life and charitable work. Ruth Somers, Larry's mother, introduced Lois to P.E.O. and after nearly 50 years in P.E.O. Chapter C Oahu, and at the age of 96, Lois became a founding member of Chapter L Kauai. With appreciation for their parents' commitment to education, their children have established a P.E.O. Scholarship for a woman from west Kauai to further her education so she, too, can become a contributing member of society. This scholarship is a legacy to Lois and Larry's inspired lives and ideals.

A west Kauai woman graduating high school **or** furthering her post-graduate level education who has been accepted and attending an accredited U.S. or Canadian college. Applicants should exhibit excellence in leadership, academics, extracurricular activities or work life, community service and potential for future success, preferably on Kauai with an unweighted GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale. Applicants must be a citizen or legal resident of the U.S. or Canada.

Make two copies of the recommendation form and request one recommendation from a teacher and one recommendation from a community member (employer, minister, etc.). Family members cannot be used as references. Follow up to make sure their letters are submitted and postmarked by **January 30, 2025**.

HOW ARE APPLICANTS SELECTED

Applicants are selected through a two-step process, beginning with a blind scoring process where applications are ranked by a committee of reviewers. The top three highest scorers will be interviewed by the committee for final selection sometime between February 15 and March 15, 2025.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT: \$2,000.00

THE RECIPIENT BE ANNOUNCED: The scholarship winner will be notified by PEO Chapter L-HI in May. Funds will be sent directly to the college or university the recipient will be attending in the fall.



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Applicants must be a west Kauai woman graduating high school **or** furthering her post-graduate level education who has been accepted by and will attend an accredited U.S. or Canadian college. Applicants should exhibit excellence in leadership, academics, extracurricular activities or work life, community service and potential for future success, preferably on Kauai, with an unweighted GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
